



WHAT IS THE UNSW A&D 4D HUB?

UNSW Art & Design's Making Centre facilitates students with the right skills, tools and spaces to bring their creative ideas to life. The 4D Hub component of the Making Centre

comprises a diverse range of photography, film, video and sound recording, playback and display equipment.

W RESOURCE

The Resource Centre is the home to the professional photography, film, video and sound recording gear available to UNSW Art & Design students. Staff can also provide assistance identifying the correct gear for your project or assessment.





IE BLACK BO

The Black Box is a large production space that can be used for a live and multimedia performances, film and video, still image capture, motion capture, exhibitions, screenings, and installations. It is outfitted with state of the art audio visual equipment.





Our **Audio Studios** feature professional capture, recording, editing and mastering tools for multi track high definition sound in 5.1 and stereo using Pro Tools, which is suitable for any high quality student video or audio projects.





The Video Edit Suites can be used to capture, edit and finish video, ranging from an online videoclip to an entire movie with multichannel sound. The edit suites are equiped with Adobe Premiere Pro and After Effects





The **Photography** darkroom features 22 small format (35mm) enlargers, 14 of which can easily be changed to accommodate medium format (120). There are also three **Image Capture Studios** available for students to create still or moving images.







4D HUB EQUIPMENT

Staff can provide help identifying the correct gear for your project and provide assistance to the film processing lab and the black and white darkroom. Some equipment

requires some proficiency which usually is obtained during courses. Most equipment can be borrowed overnight or over the weekend for the completion of coursework.





DIGITAL AND FILM STILL CAMERAS

The 4D Hub has a range of professional level DSLR cameras including the Nikon D7000, D7200, D800 and D810. There is also a range of 35mm film cameras for students interested in film photography.



DIGITAL MOVING IMAGE CAMERAS

Students can create stunning video with cameras ranging from the Canon Legria HF25, D550 and D750, to the advanced Blackmagic Cinema Camera, Blackmagic Pocket Cameras and many more.



AUDIO EQUIPMENT

To complement the 4D Hub's extensive video resources is a wide array of audio equipment from professional recorders and microphones to speakers, amplifiers, mixers and midi keyboards.



LIGHTING and PERIPHERALS

The 4D Hub can provide innovative lighting solutions for student projects ranging from REDHEAD and DEDO lighting kits to LED lighting systems. Projectors, monitors and flat screen tvs are also available.
